APIX was launched at the Singapore FinTech Festival in 2019, with the participation of Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Singapore Senior Minister Tharman Shanmugaratnam. Based in one of the world’s FinTech hubs, APIX was engineered to offer a marketplace for FinTechs and related parties to collaborate, innovate and communicate; a sandbox for testing and coding new products and services; and a community for like-minded persons to be inspired.

About APIX: API Exchange (APIX) is an initiative of the ASEAN Financial Innovation Network (AFIN), a not-for-profit entity that was jointly formed by the Monetary Authority of Singapore (MAS), the World Bank Group’s International Finance Corporation (IFC) and the ASEAN Bankers Association. It is a global, open-architecture platform that supports financial innovation and inclusion in ASEAN and around the world

The MoU defines a medium-term agenda of information-sharing, joint-event coordination, and relationship-building between local FinTech players, and APIX’s 700+ members from around the globe. Over the next year, these synergies will be interwoven in a series of activities being planned by FinTechTT, which has been described by its President, Maria Daniel, as ‘a targeted, sustainable stream of programming and education that will imbed FinTech as an everyday facet of the livelihoods of T&T citizens – as we emerge into an ever more digitalised era.’

To oversee and coordinate this programme, FinTechTT has engaged Ms. Helen Llanos who will take up the mantle of FinTechTT’s inaugural Executive Manager.
